Job Summary:

The Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) provides basic emergency medical care and transportation for patients requiring various needs in the pre-hospital environment. This role involves responding to emergency calls, providing high-quality patient care, and ensuring the safe transport of patients to medical facilities. The EMT is responsible for assessing and treating patients at the BLS level. The ideal candidate will have strong clinical skills, the ability to remain calm under pressure, and a commitment to public service.

Key Responsibilities:

- Emergency Response: Respond promptly to emergency calls and provide basic life support (BLS) care to patients.
- Patient Care: Assess patients' conditions, administer appropriate medical treatment, and monitor vital signs.
- Medical Procedures: Perform basic medical procedures such as CPR, bandaging, and splinting.
- Transport: Safely transport patients to medical facilities while providing continuous medical care.
- Documentation: Accurately document patient care reports and maintain patient confidentiality.
- Equipment Maintenance: Ensure all medical equipment and vehicles are properly maintained, stocked, and ready for use.
- Public Interaction: Serve as a public relations representative for the EMS department, providing information and assistance to the community.

- Vision and hearing within normal ranges.
